
Mr. Massey is currently employed as a Recreation Assistant in the MCC/WSRU Recreation Department. He has held this position for over a year.

Mr. Massey has not been found guilty of a serious infraction since 1996, which was the same year he earned his High School General Equivalency Degree (GED) here at MCC/WSRU.

Mr. Massey maintains a positive attitude and has become an effective role model for other offenders by his good example. Mr. Massey is a team player who communicates effectively and politely with staff as well as other offenders. Mr. Massey also maintains his cell in a high standard of cleanliness.
